C I T A T I O N

The 458th Bombardment Group (H), is cited for distinguished and outstanding performance of duty in combat from 2 March 1944 to 19 July 1944. Attacking during this period of one hundred (100) operations, forty-four (44) targets in Germany and fifty-six (56) targets in enemy occupied territories, this unit dropped over four thousand (4,000) tons of bombs against vital enemy installations, thereby contributing materially to the success of the aerial war. In overcoming fierce enemy fighter opposition on many occasions, gunners of the 458th Bombardment Group destroyed over twenty-five (25) enemy aircraft. The devotion to duty, skill and high degree of cooperation exhibited by both air and ground personnel were outstanding factors in the achievement accomplished and reflect great credit upon themselves, their organization, and the United States Army Air Forces.
